Just when you think Walden Lake LLC had submitted their final proposal for redevelopment, Florida legislators pass Senate Bill 102, "Live Local Act" which was enacted on July 1st. Due to this statewide bill, which takes local control away from the residences in certain types of land redevelopment, we now have a letter of intent by Walden Lake LLC to build 1530 multi-family units, 468 townhomes configured in 1 and 2 bedrooms up to 3 stories. **This new plan will almost double the current density/ population of Walden Lake**. Presently, there are 2200 homes and 200 townhomes in the built-out Walden Lake planned community. For the record, their prior proposal offering 173 single family units and 356 rental units, was turned down by the Plant City planning board for very specific and non-conforming issues.

Walden Lake LLC's current proposal, could be approved by a single Plant City staff member per SB 102 without going establish protocols. This doubling of density, all without allowing local input from the residences, Planning board members and elected Plant City Commissioners, will unquestionably alter Walden Lake community and Plant City forever.

We must all immediately contact our Florida representatives in order to stop this bill. With an overwhelming amount of communications from concerned citizens, which are all monitored, will motivate our Florida representatives to take action.
